Dress Down Day

Employees pay to come into work in their casual clothes

Jailbreak

Employees offer to share their skills with their team for a small price, or the company auctions off its own expertise. Colleagues could offer sewing lessons, a home-cooked dinner or a cake for a special occasion while your company could offer packages of its own such as an hour's free IT support, a training session or a free product to the highest bidder.

Employees, clients, friends of the company pay money to enter the bake off; you can hold raffles or other competitions on the day too. You could also make this into a summer tea party or a Christmas Prosecco brunch.

You could hold a Christmas carol concert and donate the entry fee or bucket shaking donations to Jigsaw4u

Even easier than that is Christmas Jumper Day. Similar to the dress down day, employees pay a small price for the luxury of wearing their Christmas jumper to work. Prizes for the most garish will make it all the funnier!
