We are currently celebrating Jigsaw4u's 20^{th} anniversary — a wonderful achievement for a charity in challenging financial times. Jigsaw4u has always kept true to its original purpose of giving children and young people a voice in the decisions that affect their lives and 'helping them to put the pieces back together'.

I would like to pay tribute to Anne Davies, the founder and CEO of Jigsaw4u who had the original vision of establishing Jigsaw4u in May 1997. It has grown so much since those early days. I have had the privilege of being involved for 18 years in various roles — Grief Support Project Worker, Head of Service and over the last 6 years as Trustee, Friend of Jigsaw4u and Chair. So, I have known the work from all angles. I am always impressed by the passion and commitment of the people who are involved — the children and young people, families, staff, trustees, volunteers and colleagues in other agencies and our many donors.

Jigsaw4u has a remarkable breadth and depth of services and over the last year has reached an impressive 4000 children, young people and their families. I would like to thank the team for all they have achieved over the last year.

There are so many people who have helped Jigsaw4u over the last 20 years. I cannot begin to name them all — but we appreciate everything you do. The need for our services continues to grow — we have ambitious plans and hope that you will continue to support us over the next 20 years so that we can reach out to evermore children and young people.



Did you know?



50% of those with life time mental illness will experience symptoms by the age of 14.

112 children nationally were bereaved of a parent each day last year.

Bereavement of suicide is a key factor in young people who take their own lives.

Early intervention avoids children and young people falling in to crisis and avoids expensive and longer term interventions.

How Jigsaw4u helps

- This year has seen Jigsaw4u deliver services to over **4000** children, young people and their families
- We have delivered 460 groups, 7639 1:1 sessions for children and 1512 for adults

Home School Links Service

- A service was provided to 2287 children
- Staff delivered 5627 one to one sessions
- 100% of children who received the service reported improvements on all scales of the Outcomes Star

Pre and Post Bereavement Service

- 504 children and adults assessed for a service.
- 173 children received intensive individual support sessions
- 163 adults were supported
- 1129 individual sessions were delivered
- 45 individuals received group work support
- In the past year we have seen an 85% increase of referrals for children and young people affected by sudden and accidental death
- We received 671 telephone calls requesting advice and guidance about how to talk to children and young people about life threatening diagnosis and death.

Missing and CSE

This year we have taken referrals of **1196 missing episodes** across **Merton and Sutton boroughs**.

Southside House Christmas 2016



Singing and drama workshops

Throughout the year, a large number of children and young people have attended workshops put on by talented theatre groups who support Jigsaw4u.

Baseless Fabric theatre company has given children the opportunity to take part in opera workshops where they have learnt arias and operatic singing techniques.





And our long-time supporters Magical Quests theatre company have helped our young people to devise a 'play-in-a-day' alongside their team of professional actors and musicians.









Littlehampton

This summer, we paid our fourth annual visit to Littlehampton with a large group of children, young people, parents, staff and volunteers. We had a great day and enjoyed some time on the beach having a paddle in the waves while others took themselves off to do a spot of crabbing. A fish and chip lunch was followed by a visit to the arcade, then ice creams and home time.







Jigsaw4u events

We now have three annual events in the Jigsaw4u calendar that not only provide fun and participation for our service users and supporters, but also helps to increase the Jigsaw4u profile whilst raising much needed funds.

Valentines ball

In February this year we held Jigsaw4u's first ever fundraising ball.

The glittering event took place at The Selsdon Park Hotel where 240 guests enjoyed live music, three course dinner and drinks, casino, dancing, as well as an auction and a raffle. As our bereavement team have experienced a notable increase in referrals for children affected by suicide and sudden death the funds raised from this event will go directly to support them.

The exhibition brought together children and young people across many of the projects at Jigsaw4u to showcase their creative talents and ran for four weeks in the exhibition space in the Stable Yard within the National Trust's Morden Hall Park.
